**Information:**

**Tryouts:**

**August 11 & 12 from 2:00 – 4:00 pm on the Fields at Upper Elementary.**

Tryouts are open to boys enrolled in Ozark R-VI Schools in grades 6 through 8.

*Note: If it is raining or the fields are too wet, tryouts may be postponed until sometime between August 13-16.. If postponed, announcements will be posted on the ozarktigersoccer.com website. Roster decisions will be finalized by 8/17.*

Please wear shinguards and soccer cleats to tryouts if possible.

Also, please bring a size 5 soccer ball and a bottle of water.

**Practice:**

Training dates will vary each week. A schedule will be provided at the beginning of the season. Training during the week will be from 5:30 – 7:00 (and 2:00 – 4:00 on Sundays). We will do our best to work with the competitive soccer coaches to develop a schedule that will work for the majority of the players. We hope to have a total of 24 training sessions over 12 weeks.

**Games:**

Games will be played at Lake Country Soccer Complex in Springfield.

The season will consist of at least eight (8) games beginning in September.

Depending on the number of players who tryout, some players might be asked to swing between varsity and JV and play two games per week.

Cost of participating in the league is \$60 per player, which includes the cost of the printed t-shirts that every team is required to wear as jerseys.

**General:**

This program is designed to help develop players who might be interested in playing high school soccer in Ozark. If we have enough players for two teams, the varsity team will be competitive and playing time will not be equal or guaranteed. The JV team will be more of a developmental team and playing time will be shared more evenly.
